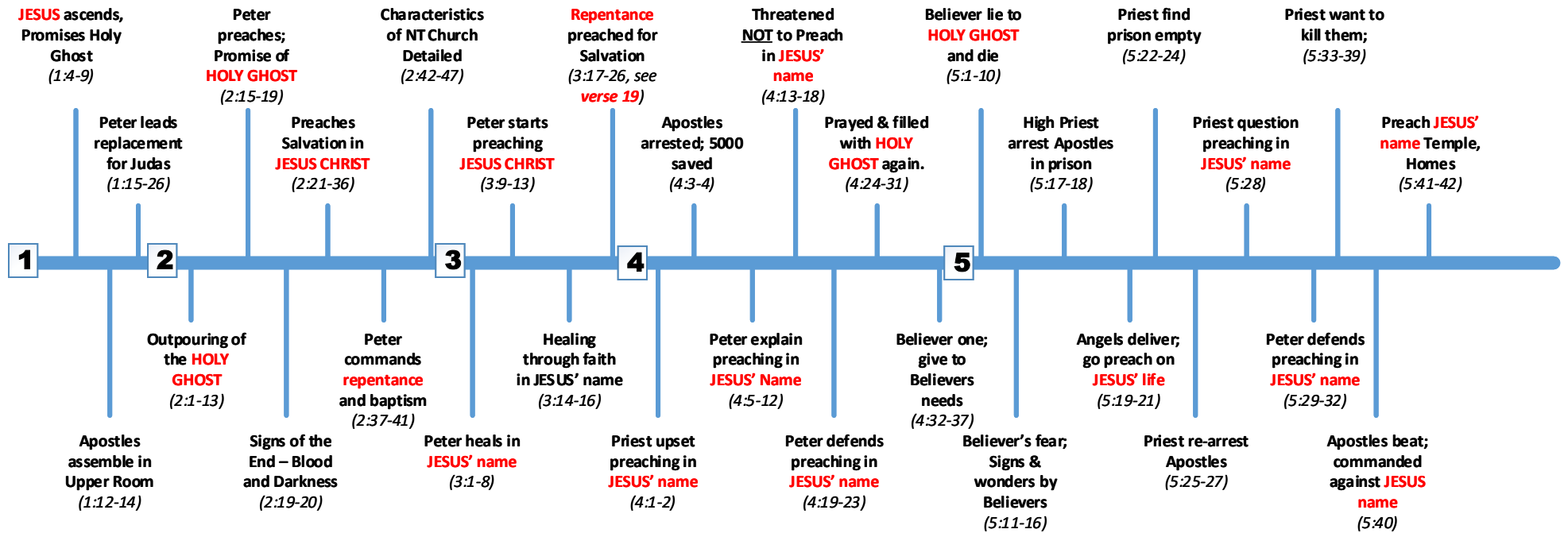


Chart of Characteristics of NT Church
